

The Reading Half Marathon Corporate Relay Challenge

takes place at the same time as the Reading Half Marathon and on the same, flat and fast course. You'll experience the atmosphere of one of the country's best supported road races finishing in the magnificent Madejski Stadium.

All you have to do is:

- Get your team together, consisting of four runners, each of whom will run approximately three miles, except the last person who runs four miles.
- Fill out this form (every member of the team will need to sign the race declaration).
- Start fundraising.
- Send the completed entry form together with a cheque made payable to Sweatshop for £70 to: **Sweatshop Events, 12 Station Road, Hampton, Middlesex, TW12 2BX**
- All entrants for the Reading Half Marathon Corporate Relay Challenge must be registered by 12 noon on 26th February 2010.

There will be two winners in the Reading Half Marathon Corporate Relay Challenge:

- The fastest team on the day.
- The team raising the most money for charity.

Fundraising can be for the Reading Half Marathon official charities or your company's favourite charity. You decide.

RULES FOR THE READING HALF MARATHON CORPORATE RELAY CHALLENGE

1. Entry to the Reading Half Marathon Corporate Relay Challenge will be open to proprietors of any UK registered business, company or corporation. **2.** Whilst registered charities are not eligible to enter, they should encourage businesses to enter on their behalf. **3.** Teams will consist of four participants – all of who must be at least 17 years of age on 21st March 2010. **4.** Each participant must run or walk between three and four miles. The change over point for each participant will be at nominated stations. **5.** Participants must be full or part time staff of participating companies. **6.** The relay will be run over the Reading Half Marathon course, starting and finishing at Madejski stadium. **7.** The cost of entry is £70 per team. **8.** Each team must nominate a team captain, to whom all correspondence will be sent. **9.** Team members will be 'bussed' to their respective changeover points and picked up from their finish points. The first runner will start with the main race at the Madejski Stadium. **10.** Prizes will be awarded (on the day) to the first team to cross the finish line and to the team that raises the most money for charity (pledged by 5th March 2011). **11.** Team members must each wear the official Reading Half Marathon Corporate Relay Challenge running number on the front. Team captains will be sent these by mail in advance of the day and hand out to their team. **12.** In the event of any dispute the organisers, Sweatshop, will be the sole adjudicator and their decision will be binding on all entrants. **13.** Each participant must sign the race declaration below.
